

SAFETY, ENVIRONMENTAL AND QUALITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Health and Safety Requirements

The Contractor must comply with the Occupational Health and Safety Act of 1993, the Employer's Plant Safety Regulations OPR 3305, Operating Regulation for High Voltage Systems ESHARAAAG4 and any other safety procedures issued by the Employer.

This includes the following:

- a) Occupational Health and Safety Act 37(2) – Agreement Form
- b) Eskom SHEQ Policy, 32-727
- c) Eskom Vehicle and Drivers Safety, 32-93
- d) Eskom Vehicle Safety Specification, 32-345
- e) Eskom Substance abuse, 32-37

- g) Eskom Incident Management Procedure, 32-95
- h) Eskom Smoking Procedure, 32-36
- i) Eskom Medical Surveillance Procedure, 32-282
- j) Eskom SHE requirements, 32-726 (Annexure B and C)

The Contractor must ensure that all contractor employees attend the Employer's Health and Safety Induction Course free of charge prior to commencement of any work. The course is usually presented at the power station by the Education and Training Department (ETD), Monday to Friday and normally from 09:00 to 11:00. This is a two (2) hour course and is valid for the duration of one (1) year

2. Environmental Requirements

The Contractor must ensure that all services or substances supplied conform to all the applicable environmental legislation and where necessary dispose these substances in accordance with the applicable requirements.

- a) The Contractor shall comply with the environmental criteria and constraints as supplied by the Employer's representative.
- b) SHEQ File requirements
- c) The contractor shall comply with the Environmental Management Procedure for contractors work instruction *1018332

3. Quality Management

- a) The Contractor complies in full with the Employer Quality Requirements QM58 (Quality requirements for engineering and construction works).
- b) The Contractor submits the QCP to the Project Manager and the Project Manager accepts the QCP before any activity of the works commences.
- c) The Contractor does not continue with any activities of the works unless all relevant parties have signed off the QCP Hold and Witness Points.
- d) The Contractor provides a complete QA & QC documentation for all plant, Material and equipment in compliance with SANS 9001:2000
- e) The Contractor complies in full with the Employer's QA requirements to provide the works.
